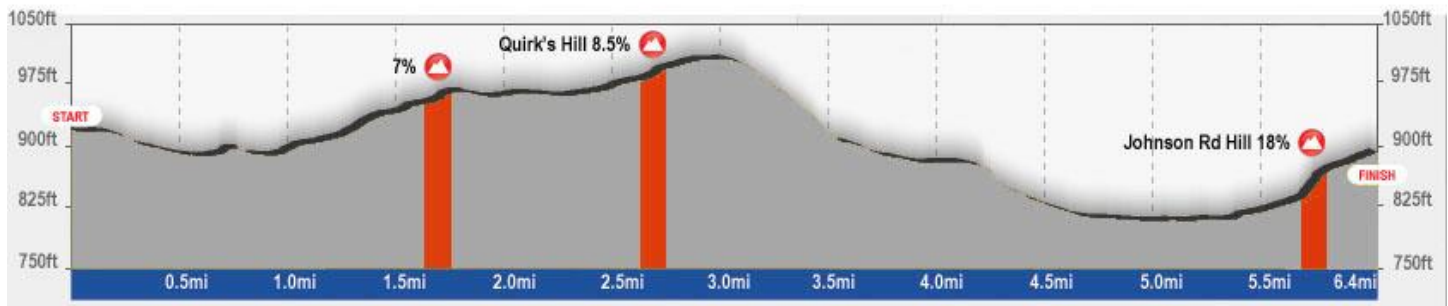

Course: Rural 6.5 mile loop with 4 corners and tendon-tearing climbs. To ensure safety and organization near start-finish, **ALL RACES WILL STAGE NEAR REGISTRATION** followed by a neutral start up to the actual start/finish on Johnson Rd.

Medals: State championship medals will be awarded to the first 3 finishers in: Both Junior Boys and Girls ages 10-12, 13-14, 15-16, 17-18. Senior Women Cat. 1/2/3 and Cat. 4. Masters Women ages 35+ and 45+. Senior Men Cat 1 / 2, Cat. 3, and Cat 4/5. Masters Men ages 30+, 35+, 40+, 45+, 50+, 55+, and 60+. Held under USAC permit. Strict centerline enforcement.

Registration: \$32 seniors, \$22 juniors, + \$8 day of registration. Second race is \$10. Minimum field size is 15 riders for full prize list. Pre-register at www.usacycling.org. Day-of registration will be available for any unfilled fields. USAC license required, one-day licenses available at registration. Registration closes when field limit is reached or 15 minutes prior to start time, whichever is first.
