- You must have a valid USAC license to race. Riders may purchase a USAC 1-day license for \$10. Registration fees include USAC & WCA surcharges. Registration begins @ 8:00 AM; ends 15 minutes before each race. Additional races entered \$10. No refunds.
- A portion of race proceeds will be donated to Luke House, a meal program serving low-income members of our community.

**Classic WoW Course:** Back where it all started: a 1km rectangular course through the historic Willy Street neighborhood (newly repaved!). Lots of great restaurants and stores nearby will be open, so bring your family and friends for a day of fun.
